Preparedness

1. The meeting convened at 9:00 a.m.
2. The minutes from the January 2, 2008 meeting were approved with changes.
3. There were no Consent Calendar items.
4. Dane LeBlanc provided a status report on the Emergency Notification System. WSU will contract with ConnectED at \$2.00 a person. This system provides voice, text messaging and e-mail capability. President's Council asked that the communications sub-committee to make decisions about who should receive notifications. The Purchase Requisition will be process.

Dane LeBlanc also reviewed the proposed order buildings will be fitted with public announcement systems. The Library will be included with the first group to receive the system. Installation of the system will continue to include all campus buildings.

Chief LeBlanc then outlined communication needs for the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) in Lampros Hall. Fifteen lines need to be activated in Room 201 when the EOC operational. If the lines are always activated, there is a monthly charge for each line. Don Gardner suggested that the lines be activated permanently, but the cost of having the lines active be waived.
